

SKOV get big order in Thailand

SKOV have made an agreement of supplying ventilation control for 198 large poultry houses in Thailand. The houses, each containing approx. 20,000 chickens, are owned by Sun Valley Ltd., which is a company in the Cargill Group, and are distributed on 18 farms in the Saraburi area north east of Bangkok.

This is the first big, local order for SKOV since the establishment of a local sales company in Thailand last year.

- I hope that this will gain a good foothold for us on the Asian market, where large amounts of poultry are being produced, says export manager Thomas O. Hansen, who is the daily leader of the sales office in Thailand.

The order comprises ventilation systems of the type tunnel ventilation, which is used in tropical regions. Large fans in the gable suck air into the house through cooling pads with running water. The cooled airstream through the house ensures the right temperature for the chickens.

The order includes a new climate computer, which SKOV have designed specially for tunnel ventilation.

Furthermore, the order includes the new communication module, Info Matic WebLink, from SKOV, which can transfer data from the climate computers to a PC via the Internet. In this way, centrally placed employees can follow the development on the various farms and change the climate computer settings, if necessary.

If the producer chooses to install SKOV production computers later on, these can be connected to Info Matic WebLink as well, so that the leading employees can have an overall survey of the climate and production data.
