

## **New managing director of SKOV A/S**

On 1 July 2005 Mr Jørgen Yde Jensen takes up the appointment as new managing director of SKOV A/S in Glyngøre.

Jørgen Yde Jensen is also well acquainted with the agricultural sector due to having an education as Farm Manager from the agricultural school Asmildkloster Landbrugsskole.

Jørgen Yde Jensen succeeds Mr Flemming Skjalm-Rasmussen who is the managing director of SKOV A/S. Flemming Skjalm-Rasmussen has chosen to retire as on 1 July 2005.
